Reusability: Is it useful anywhere else?

Reports: Would anyone be interested in this data?

Stats: Are there statistics about the process that you can collect for troubleshooting purposes?

Usability: Anticipate the needs of the customer. Especially if you're the customer.

Consistency: Will this be part of a bigger solution?

Necessity: Is the process already being covered by something else?

Technology: Assuming everything else checks out, what technology should you use? T-SQL, PowerShell, etc.

Supportability: How difficult will it be to support? Will it be worth it?
